He also went on to **Best of Breed**. **It was so exciting.** It was as if he knew it was going to happen. Before we left for the show I kept telling him that if he got his major this weekend he could stay home and be a couch potato, because he has never liked the traveling part of dog showing. He went in the ring with Lindsey, on Saturday, and had that special Irish Setter attitude and aura about him that said *"I'm here to win today - look at me float around the ring"*. He looked so majestic, head held high, grinning as he flew around the ring. The true picture of your rollicking Irish Setter. Sunday he went on to **Best of Breed** again, with Becky Zimmerman Lloyd as his handler that day.

KORRIE'S JOURNEY TO HIS CHAMPIONSHIP - CONGRATULATIONS!

I'd like to tell you about Korrie's journey to his championship. It started when I decided to stop and see my friends Barb and Ed Mooney to see how they were doing. They had just had their Cherryhill litter and wanted me to come see them when they got home. I waited a couple months, since I knew I would want one of the pups, but didn't think it was the right time. Well I took my daughter, Sam, over and we played with the pups and Korrie came and sat in my lap and wouldn't leave my side. He came home with us a couple days later and I knew I was going to get back in the show ring after 15 years standing on the side lines.

Korrie and I started his show career when he was 6 mos. old and I was 50 something. I knew that eventually he would need someone beyond me to finish his career. I so enjoyed getting back in the ring with him and having the fun of showing a pup that wanted to please me. I had fun getting involved with the Irish folks at the shows and also becoming a member of the Irish Setter Club of Michigan. During 2008 & 2009 Korrie and I had fun and he picked up a few points towards his championship.

In 2010 disaster struck at the Lause home. My daughter, Sam, Korrie's co-owner, became critically ill and was hospitalized for 3 months. So Korrie's career was put on hold, indefinitely. While Sam was in rehab, Korrie went to visit her after not seeing her for 2 1/2 months. He was a hit. Korrie had his show groom on when he went visiting and everyone had to pet him and talk to him. He got a taste of being a therapy dog.

Our bad luck in 2010 didn't end with my daughter. We lost our senior Irish, Sean, in the fall and a month later after returning from a dog show in Grand Rapids, Korrie became critically ill. The next day, I rushed Korrie to my vet, then on to a 24 hr emergency care hospital and eventually on to Michigan State University. Finally, a week later he came home for the long recovery. He had lots of extra pampering and so much support from the Setter community nationwide.

After Korrie got his health back and also his hair (IV's in his front legs took the feathering off) we decided to continue his career. Unfortunately, or fortunately depending on how you look at it, his career was at a point when I had to stand on the side lines again and watch him shine while being handled by someone else. I knew he was ready to go on and finish his conformation career. I was so happy when Lindsey (Kuhn) Cook agreed to show him for me, and away he went. She brought out a sparkle in Korrie and the first weekend she had him he acquired 4 points and his first Best of Breed, over specials. It has been just over a year since she took over Korrie and he is now finished. WOW, what a ride.

Korrie is now CH Cherryhill Over The Moon, owned by Karen Lause, Sam Lause and Ed and Barb Mooney. His Sire is: Harry, GCH Courtwood Seeker and Dam is Kari, CH Rockherin American Classic. His breeders are: Ed and Barb Mooney, Katherine Wheatley and Debbie Davis. **HOOORAYYYY!!!**
